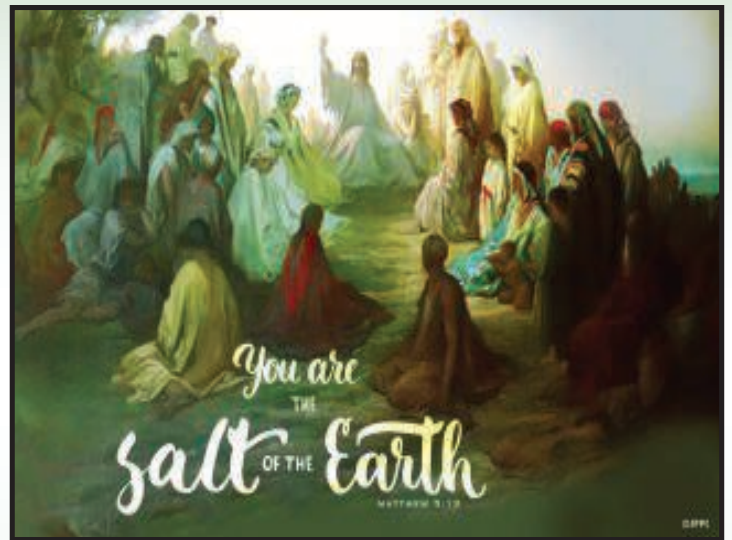

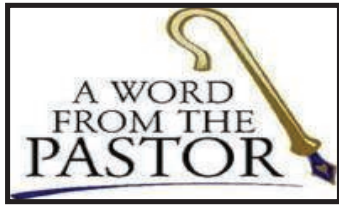

My Dear Parishioners,

Praised Be Jesus Christ! With the arrival of February, Ash Wednesday and the Season of Lent are now on the horizon. While not next week, i.e. Super Bowl week, Lent begins the following week on Wednesday, February 22<sup>nd</sup>. Amidst the various activities planned for that Sacred Season, I am happy to announce that for the first time in many years, our parish will host a **PARISH MISSION** and I am delighted to welcome as our Director, Fr Emmerich Vogt, OP. A few words about that.

A Parish Mission is special time in a parish community when the community gathers together to gain further insight into a faith filled life. It's a time for grace and renewal of the parish through services and talks filled with stories, examples and meaning. Basically, it's a retreat for the whole parish, the pastor included! It's a time to receive and be renewed.

Our director will be Fr. Emmerich Vogt, OP. He is a priest of the Holy Name Province of the Dominican Order and is currently the Director of the Saint Jude Shrine at St. Dominic's Church, San Francisco, while also ministering with Western Dominican Preaching. Born and raised in New Britain, Connecticut, where he attended Central Connecticut State College, Father received a BA degree in Philosophy from St. Albert's College in Oakland, California, an MA degree in Theology from the Graduate Theological Union in Berkeley and a graduate degree in Near Eastern Religions from the University of California. For the past forty years he has been involved in giving retreats and seminars to Mother Teresa's Priests and Sisters in Mexico, Poland, Guatemala, Uruguay, Calcutta, Madagascar, Russia, and Africa. He is a frequent guest on EWTN and has authored many works on Spirituality and the 12-Steps for Christians. His topic/theme for the Mission will be **Eu-charistic Principles for the Spiritual Life**.

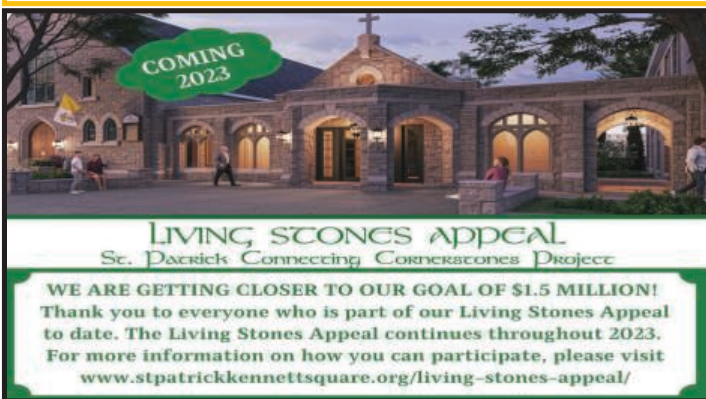
The Dates for the Mission are **Monday, March 6 to Thursday, March 9<sup>th</sup>**. On each of those days, Fr. Emmerich will celebrate Daily Mass, hear confessions and offer a Conference. The same daily conference will be offered twice, in the morning and in the evening. Throughout this time, our Church will be opened for Eucharistic Adoration on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday from after the morning conference until the evening.

I ask you to make note of this special **PARISH MISSION** and consider inviting some friends. A flyer/ advertisement and more details will be forthcoming. But for now, reserve the week! I am very much looking forward to this experience. Years ago, I listened to a course that Fr. Emmerich gave on the SPIRITUAL LIFE and it had a profound effect on me. Never did I dream that I would be able to welcome him one day to my parish. But that day has come! Praise God!

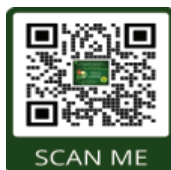

## CULTURE OF LIFE CORNER

*“Human trafficking is a crime against humanity. We must unite our efforts to free victims and stop this crime.” ~ Pope Francis*

**DID YOU KNOW?** February 8th has been designated by the Pontifical Council for Justice and Peace and the International Union of Superiors General as an **annual day of prayer and awareness against human trafficking**. February 8th is the feast day of St. Josephine Bakhita, who was kidnapped as a child and sold into slavery in Sudan and Italy. She learned from Canossian nuns that she was created in the image of God and possessed human dignity. Once she asserted herself and refused to be enslaved, Josephine became a Canossian sister and dedicated her life to sharing her testament of deliverance from slavery and comforting the poor and suffering. She was declared a Saint in 2000.

### Facts about Human Trafficking:

The International Labor Organization (ILO) and Walk Free Foundation’s “Global Estimate of Modern Slavery” (2016) provides alarming statistics on the prevalence of human trafficking worldwide:

- There are an estimated 40.3 million victims of modern-day slavery worldwide. Of these, 25 million are victims of labor or sex trafficking and 15 million are people trapped in forced marriages.
- 25% of all victims are children ages 17 or younger, representing 10 million girls and boys worldwide.
- Nearly 30% of all victims are men and boys; jumping to 46% for victims of forced labor.

### The Church’s Position on Human Trafficking:

- The elimination of human trafficking is a priority issue for the Catholic Church. Because every life is a gift from God and is sacred, it deserves to be protected and nurtured; we each have a responsibility to fight against the violation and degradation of our brothers and sisters.
- The Catechism of the Church forbids acts that cause the enslavement of humans. During the Second Vatican Council in 1965, the Church further stated “slavery, prostitution, the selling of women, and children, and disgraceful working conditions where people are treated as mere tools for profits rather than free and responsible persons are infamies and supreme dishonor to the creator.” (Gaudium et Spes, 1965).
