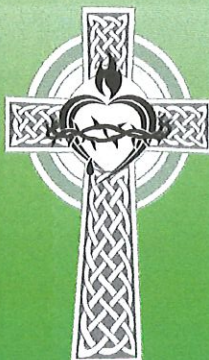

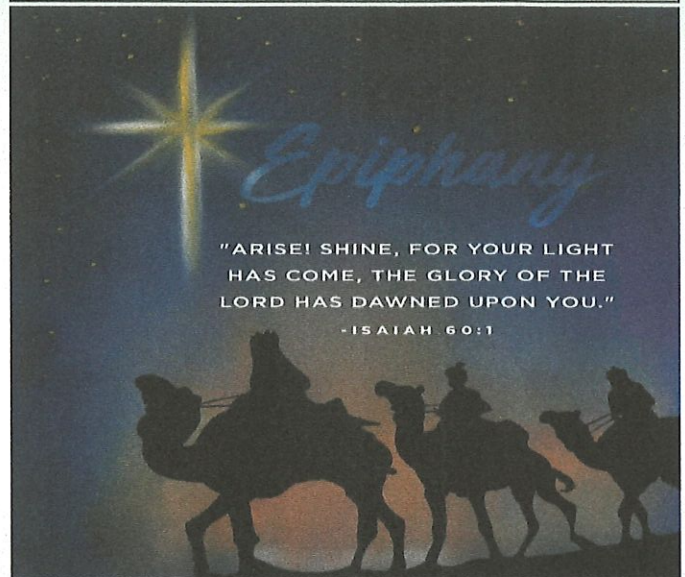

My Dear Parishioners,

Greetings Everyone! Praised be Jesus Christ and Happy New Year 2021!! Still in this Sacred Season full of lights, hope, angels and décor, we welcome on this Epiphany Weekend the Magi to the Christmas scene as the Christmas Miracle continues to unfold.

In this context and as we enter this first full week of the New Year, I'd like to say a word about miracles. **What do you think -- how do you think -- of miracles? Do you believe in them?** These may sound like strange questions but I think they are important for us especially as we live in such skeptical times; times when people are looking for Hope. St. Francis prayed that he be a Christian of **Right faith, Certain Hope and Perfect Love**. And Church Teaching on miracles can assist that so 3 points on Miracles:

1. Catholic Christianity absolutely professes faith in miracles. We do so because miracles are found throughout the Scripture. Jesus, Himself, worked them and even before Jesus in the Old Testament, we find them. What's more even in the early Church and today, there are miracles as the Life of God continues in and with His People, the Church.
2. What is a miracle? According to the Catholic Church, a miracle is **an extraordinary sensible effect wrought by God that surpasses the power and order of created nature**. This is a very precise definition. Note the following: 1) Miracles are exclusively attributable to God. 2) Beyond the power or order of created nature. 3) Something sensible, i.e. able to be perceived. There are three categories of miracles: Physical, Moral (conversion stories involving virtue) and Intellectual (receiving knowledge from God).
3. Christian Faith rests upon the two greatest miracles are the **INCARNATION and RESURRECTION of Jesus Christ**.

What is the Miracle of the Incarnation? Well, that is what we are now celebrating and which continues forever. The fact that God become man; That the 2nd Person of the Holy Trinity, Jesus, conceived in the womb of Mary by the Holy Spirit; That Divine and Human Nature are now united in the one person of Jesus Christ. That is the miracle of the Incarnation. What a miracle that is! It's so miraculous that the early Church referred to it as a Scandal. A Happy and Blessed Scandal that God would love us so much.

My friends, as Christmas continues, let us continue to marvel, wonder and praise God for the Miracle of Christmas. It's certainly not a fairy tale...It is the Event that has turned the world upside down. ALLELUIA!!

THE EPIPHANY OF THE LORD

**Christian, Remember Your Dignity:  
A Sermon of St. Leo the Great, Pope**

Dearly beloved, today our Saviour is born; let us rejoice. Sadness should have no place on the birthday of life. The fear of death has been swallowed up; life brings us joy with the promise of eternal happiness.

No one is shut out from this joy; all share the same reason for rejoicing. Our Lord, victor over sin and death, finding no man free from sin, came to free us all. Let the saint rejoice as he sees the palm of victory at hand. Let the sinner be glad as he receives the offer of forgiveness. Let the pagan take courage as he is summoned to life.

In the fullness of time, chosen in the unfathomable depths of God's wisdom, the Son of God took for himself our common humanity in order to reconcile it with its creator. He came to overthrow the devil, the origin of death, in that very nature by which he had overthrown mankind.

And so at the birth of our Lord the angels sing in joy: *Glory to God in the highest*, and they proclaim *peace to men of good will* as they see the heavenly Jerusalem being built from all the nations of the world. When the angels on high are so exultant at this marvelous work of God's goodness, what joy should it not bring to the lowly hearts of men?

Beloved, let us give thanks to God the Father, through his Son, in the Holy Spirit, because in his great love for us he took pity on us, and *when we were dead in our sins he brought us to life with Christ*, so that in him we might be a new creation. Let us throw off our old nature and all its ways and, as we have come to birth in Christ, let us renounce the works of the flesh.

Christian, remember your dignity, and now that you share in God's own nature, do not return by sin to your former base condition. Bear in mind who is your head and of whose body you are a member. Do not forget that you have been rescued from the power of darkness and brought into the light of God's kingdom.

Through the sacrament of baptism you have become a temple of the Holy Spirit. Do not drive away so great a guest by evil conduct and become again a slave to the devil, for your liberty was bought by the blood of Christ.

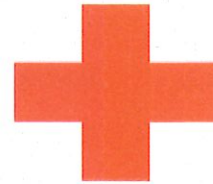

### GUIDELINES FOR ATTENDING MASS IN THE GREEN PHASE

At all Masses, provide and wear a face covering. Exceptions are "children younger than 2 years old, anyone who has trouble breathing and anyone who is incapacitated or unable to remove the cloth face covering without assistance." (CDC Guidelines) Please provide your own worship materials as missalettes will not be available. You are encouraged to take a Church Bulletin when entering Church as it will have the Hymns and Responsorial Psalm to follow the Celebration of Mass. Hand sanitizers will be available in the back of Church; it is recommended that you bring your own.

After exiting your car, please maintain social distancing as you walk on Church grounds. Before entering the Church, please put on your face covering and ensure that it covers both your nose and mouth. Ushers/Greeters will be present at all Masses who can answer any questions you may have regarding returning to Church and can assist you with any seating needs.

Pews will be marked off to allow for some measure of social distancing. Please space yourselves appropriately.

During Mass a collection will be taken up during the Offertory as usual with long-handled baskets. The procession with the Gifts during the Offertory is omitted. There will be no Sign of Peace and the Precious Blood will not be distributed.

Priests/Deacons may or may not wear a mask while distributing Communion. Sanitizer remains nearby if needed. The faithful are encouraged to receive the Body of Christ in the hand. For those wishing to receive on the tongue, the Priest/Deacon/EM will need to sanitize after each communion. Please be mindful of others. Those who desire to receive Communion, exit your pew towards the side aisle while maintaining social distancing in the Communion line. At the first pew, remove one side of your face covering. When the person in front of you has received Communion, proceed to the Communion Minister to receive the Body of Christ. Reposition your mask and return to your pew via the center aisle while allowing for social distancing.

At the conclusion of Mass, pews will exit through the center aisle one at a time from back to front. Please wait for the Usher's guidance. Pews will be cleaned between all Sunday Masses.

Thank you for your continued kindness and prudence to one another during this time.
