Day 1 Easter Monday, April 22: Depart for Ireland

Depart Philadelphia International Airport via American Airlines for our flight to Ireland.

Complimentary meals and beverages will be served in-flight. (D,B)

Day 2 Tuesday, April 23: Arrive in Shannon | Corrib River Cruise | Galway

Morning arrival at Shannon International Airport, proceed through Passport Control, claim our luggage and a Peter’s Way tour manager /guide will meet us as we exit Customs. Board our comfortable touring bus and we will be on our way to Galway, the capital of the west, affectionately known as “The City of the Tribes.” Upon arrival in Galway, enjoy a Corrib River Cruise. This journey on the Corrib Princess will take us along the majestic River Corrib and onto the lake, providing wonderful views of historic monuments and natural amenities that make this one of the most spectacular waterways in Ireland. Independent lunch. **Afternoon Mass at Galway Cathedral.** Continue to the hotel for group check-in.

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Galway. (D)

Day 3 Wednesday, April 24: Connemara | Kylemore Abbey | Knock Shrine

Irish breakfast at our hotel. This morning, travel through the Connemara Region en route to Kylemore Abbey. This is the country of The Quiet Man and The Purple Taxi – two famous films made in this region. It is an area full of contrast, granite mountains populated only by sheep, with hundreds of lakes forming a fisherman’s paradise, and its seacoast with many sandy beaches. Its stone walls, small farms and thatched cottages in isolated splendor, with its heather covered hills, create an unforgettable scene for all its visitors. A tour takes us from Galway to the lake-dotted center of Connemara at Maam Cross. Continue on to visit the famous lake-side Kylemore Abbey, in the heart of Connemara. Originally a castle, built in 1867 as a romantic gift, Kylemore is steeped in history and tales of romance, tragedy and success. Now home to Ireland’s only community of Benedictine nuns since 1920, this 1,000-acre estate offers visitors the experience of a Victorian atmosphere in the restored rooms of the Abbey, a miniature Gothic church and Head Gardiner’s House. Relax in the coffee shop and enjoy the Kylemore Abbey Craft & Design Shop. Independent lunch. Continue to Ireland’s National Marian Shrine in Knock, County Mayo. The Story of Knock began on the evening of August 21, 1879 when the Virgin Mary, St. Joseph and St. John the Evangelist appeared at the south gable of the church at Knock. Beside them and a little to their left was an altar with a cross and the figure of a lamb, around which angels hovered. There were fifteen official witnesses to the apparition who watched and prayed for two hours in the pouring rain. Since then, this Marian Shrine has attracted millions of pilgrims each year from all over the world. The special message of Knock is the need for Penance. **Participate at the 3:00 pm scheduled Mass and blessing of the sick at the Basilica or celebrate Mass as a group in the Apparition Chapel.** Late afternoon, return to Galway.

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Galway. (B,D)

Day 4 Thursday, April 25: Burren Region | Cliffs of Moher | Dunguaire Castle and Banquet

Irish breakfast at our hotel. Begin our day with **Mass at Galway Cathedral.** After Mass, we will drive through the spectacular Burren Region (‘Boirean’ is the Irish word for rocky). The region was sculpted over the last two million years by glaciers, through the exposure and submergence of its landscape to ice, ocean and the plate movements of the earth. We will stop at the Cliffs of Moher, the famous majestic cliffs that rise over 700 feet from the Atlantic Ocean and extend for over four miles. From this height, you can see the Aran Islands and Connemara Mountains (weather permitting). Independent lunch at the Cliffs of Moher. Afternoon return to hotel in Galway. Freshen-up. **Evening Medieval Banquet at Dunguaire Castle.** Dunguaire Castle is a small 17th century castle on a rocky promontory, situated just outside the picturesque village of Kinvara on the shores of Galway Bay. Following a warm welcome from the butler, savor a goblet of Mead while enjoying fine Irish music on fiddle and harp. Learn about the history of the castle and proceed up the spiral staircase to the banquet hall. Here ‘King Guaire’ is crowned and presides over our banquet for the evening. During dinner (a sumptuous four-course meal with red and white wine) the castle ladies will regale in song accompanied by the Irish Harp. Following dinner, the castle entertainers will present a program of music, song, poetry, and prose reading with some humorous scenes from Irish literature.

Overnight at hotel in Galway. (B,D)

Day 5 Friday, April 26: Dingle Peninsula | Killarney

Irish breakfast at our hotel. This morning, head south to the Dingle Peninsula, one of Ireland’s most popular coastal scenery drives. Dingle is the most northern of

the Kerry peninsulas. This peninsula is famous for its Celtic, pre-Christian monuments and Christian churches. It is also a ‘Gaeltacht’ (Irish-speaking) area, where the Irish language and traditional ways of life are preserved. Dingle town itself is a thriving fishing town and offers plenty of opportunity for shopping or simply savoring the atmosphere of a typical country Irish town with its plentiful pubs, narrow streets and busy harbor. **Celebrate Mass at St. Mary’s Church in Dingle Town.** Independent lunch in Dingle Town. Continue on the road around the Dingle Peninsula and pass through a chain of Mountains, called Slieve Mish. From Inch, a long beach bordered by dunes and made famous by David Lean’s movie Ryan’s Daughter, admire the Iveragh Peninsula and Rossbeigh Beach. Drive around the coast to Sleah Head. Here, the blue of the marine landscape surrounds the Blasket Islands, deserted since 1953. In the distance are the two rocky Skellig islands, where the ruins of an early Christian Monastery can be found. The Dingle Peninsula will charm you with its villages painted in bright colors and bewitch you with the dramatic beauty of its landscapes. We will visit Gallarus Oratory, the most impressive early Christian monument on the Dingle peninsula. It has withstood the passage of time for over 1200 years. Built in the shape of an upturned boat, the oratory formed part of a larger monastic site and was used as a place of prayer and reflection. Continue to Killarney for hotel check-in.

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Killarney. (B,D)

Day 6 Saturday, April 27: Ring of Kerry | Muckross House

Irish breakfast at our hotel. Our day begins with highlights of the Ring of Kerry. The Ring of Kerry is the most famous panoramic route in Ireland (over 100 miles). The astonishing beauty of the Iveragh Peninsula comes from the great diversity of its scenery, which offers incessant contrasts. En route around the Ring, enjoy spectacular scenery of mountains, peat bogs, lakes and magnificent views of the Atlantic Ocean. Leaving Killarney we pass through Killorglin, famous for its Puck Fair, then to Glenbeigh where the cliff road affords panoramic views of the Dingle Peninsula and Dingle Bay. Independent lunch. This afternoon we will visit Muckross House & Gardens. Muckross is a magnificent Victorian mansion built in 1843 and is one of Ireland’s leading stately homes. The Gardens of Muckross House are famed for their beauty worldwide. In particular they are noted for their collections of azaleas and rhododendrons. After our visit, continue to the town of Killarney and **celebrate Mass at St. Mary’s Cathedral.** Option: Tour and tasting at Killarney Brewing Company, Irish Craft Brewery.

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Killarney. (B,D)

Day 7 Sunday, April 28: Blarney Castle | Dublin

Irish breakfast at our hotel. Begin our day with **Mass at the Franciscan Friary in Killarney.** After Mass, depart for County Cork to visit Blarney Castle, where you just might gain the gift of eloquent speech! A stop will be made for shopping at Blarney Woollen Mills, which sells high quality Irish crafts. Continue to the city of Waterford, a walled city of Viking origin which retains much of its Medieval character. Visit the Waterford Crystal Visitor Centre and manufacturing facility. Our factory tour will include: wooden mold making, crystal blowing and quality inspection and finishing, crystal cutting, crystal sculpting and engraving, chandelier assembly and design inspiration. Independent lunch. We leave Blarney to Dublin for hotel check-in.

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Dublin. (B,D)

Day 8 Monday, April 29: Highlights of Dublin | Guinness Tour

Irish breakfast at our hotel. **Begin our day with Mass** (to be advised). After Mass, we’ll explore Dublin’s “Fair City!” Our highlights tour will take us to Trinity College, to view The Book of Kells, followed by a visit to St. Patrick’s Cathedral. The gothic cathedral, built in 1213, is the largest in Ireland, with a splendid interior adorned with funeral monuments. Independent lunch followed by a unique walking **tour of the Guinness Storehouse.** Enjoy a Pint of Guinness while enjoying epic views of Dublin from the Guinness Gravity Bar. Return to out hotel for dinner.

Overnight at hotel in Dublin. (B,D)

Day 9 Tuesday, April 30: Excursion to Wickow & Glendalough

Irish breakfast at our hotel. After breakfast, we leave Dublin for Wicklow tour. Glendalough, tucked away in the Wicklow Hills. Glendalough is a valley of two lakes and a monastery of two Saints. The monastery has two foci—one at each of the two lakes in the valley. The upper one is simpler and more austere, evocative of the eremitical side of St. Kevin’s life; the lower one has the more famous monuments, one of the best-preserved round towers in the country, the diminutive Priest’s House, which is probably the Saint’s tomb-shrine. **Celebrate Mass at the Shrine of St. Kevin.** Independent lunch. After lunch, continue to Avoca. We will Visit Avoca Hand Weavers, situated in the charming village of Avoca, in the heart of a gentle valley. Avoca Hand Weavers is the oldest surviving business in Ireland, dating from 1723. You will see the three different kinds of weaving, including the traditional fly shuttle handloom, still in use today.

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Dublin. (B,D)

Day 10 Wednesday, May 1: Return from Dublin

After breakfast, we will be transferred by coach to Dublin Airport for our flight home.

Acceptance of these Terms & Conditions, with signature on enrollment form, is required for participation in this tour.

PAYMENT: Deposits and insurance payments will be accepted in the form of check, money order or debit/credit card. A discount of \$100.00 per person will apply for payments made entirely by personal check, money order or certified bank check. AIR TRANSPORTATION: Round trip economy class on **American Airlines from Philadelphia.** Flight itinerary and carrier may be subject to change. Departure taxes & fuel surcharges are estimated. They are determined solely by the airlines and are subject to increase prior to ticketing (approximately 30 days prior to departure).

AIRLINE SEATING: Under group airline reservations/contracts, the airlines will provide a block of seats for the group. If you require specific seating as a condition of your travel, it is suggested that you book your airfare individually and purchase the land only package. LAND ONLY PASSENGERS: Land Only packages do not include any portion of the group airfare. **All airline tickets will be your responsibility to book independently.** A passenger choosing the land only portion of the package (**\$2,490.00 per person sharing a twin room - a \$100 cash discount will be applied if all payments are made by check**) must notify Peter's Way Tours, in writing, 100 days prior to date of departure or a penalty fee will be assessed. Please be advised, passenger(s) opting for the Land Only package or who are deviating from the group itinerary will be responsible for their own transfers to/from hotel/airport. However, if you arrive at the same time or earlier than your group, you are welcome to join the group on the bus. Additionally, if you purchase your own air transportation and the group does not materialize or you cancel your package for any reason, Peter's Way Tours will not be held responsible for the cost of your airfare.

DEVIATIONS & ITINERARY CHANGES: Peter's Way Tours is pleased to assist clients with changes in itineraries. All deviation requests must be submitted in writing at least 90 days prior to departure. Deviation fee will apply plus an airline change fee per person. Your routing and dates requested will determine if a difference in airfare will also apply. Married couples may request a double bed, however, double beds are subject to availability. Triple rooms (two twin beds plus rollaway) may be requested, however, there is no discount for triple occupancy. Single rooms may be requested at time of booking. If confirmed, an **additional charge of \$595.00** will apply. We will make every effort to accommodate roommate requests, but we cannot guarantee double occupancy. If a single room must be assigned due to your roommate's cancellation, incompatibility or for any other reason (even at the last moment or while on tour), we must charge you the tour's single supplement or pro-rated amount.

MEALS: Breakfast and dinner daily, including a festive banquet at Dunguaire Castle. Special tour of the Guinness Storehouse in Dublin is included.

GRATUITIES & SERVICE CHARGES: Gratuities are not included in your tour package. For good work, we recommend €4 Euro per person per day for your tour manager; €2 Euro per person per day for your bus driver; €1.50 Euro per person for a local guide when applicable. Other gratuities are usually handled individually. All service charges and local taxes as imposed by hotels are included in the program rate. Although service charges at the hotels are included, it is customary to leave €1 Euro per person for your waiter following dinner at the hotel and €1 Euro per person per day for housekeeping.
